Subject: Follow-up on calls about UHW-W participation in the national C.N.A. campaign

I have received several calls about UHW-W participation in the C.N.A. campaign. Sal emailed Jamie Cohen today to ask if anyone was going to talk with UHW. Since several locals have called to ask what UHW-W is doing, I wanted to outline what would be useful for UHW-W to do as part of the Division effort to get C.N.A. to stop their union-busting.

- 1) We need 10-12 staff assigned full-time beginning April 8th
- 2) We need trainings with all UHW-W worksite leaders and worksite meetings on the C.N.A. campaign to begin the week of 4/14.
- 3) We need twice weekly distribution of national leaflets at all UHW-W/C.N.A. worksites
- 4) UHW-W public condemnation of RoseAnn DeMoro leadership – the message and form to be worked on jointly with the Division Campaign team
- 5) a series of actions that we need to develop jointly with UHW-W to move the condemnation of C.N.A. conduct, UHW-W leaders will have lots of ideas about where/how to apply pressure for C.N.A. to do the right thing.
- 6) additional ideas can be generated through a joint call – many locals are volunteering sets of ideas and making plans in their states, we would welcome UHW-W contribution to implementing our national resolution.
- 7) Take down the UHW-W public websites attacking our Union so the C.N.A. cannot use them against our members and non-union workers by referring workers to the sites and supplying printed material in hospital breakrooms.
